
How To Draw A Landscape

Draw your landscape lightly the first time you draw it so you can erase any mistakes without ruining the picture.



Trase over a small part of your picture. In this case draw the canyon. Make sure your canyon is on the left side of the paper and that it's not too big nor to small.



Add detail to your canyon to make it look more realistic. What I did was add cracks in the canyon but other things you can do is add shade or color.



Add a volcano to the top of your canyon and if you want add some lava like I did.



Add sand from the bottom of the canyon to about ¾ to the top of the canyon but on the right side of the paper.



Draw the water from about ¾ of the canyon high to a little bit below the top of the sand.




Add detail to the sand so again it can look more realistic. I again used lines but you can use shade or color if you want to.




Add detail to the water so it looks like water so it looks better.







Add the sun so about half of it shows above the water creating a sunset.




Add two palm trees to the top of the sand. You can add lines on the trunk to make it look realistic and don't forget the leaves.




Going back to the volcano (If you added lava), add an eruption like I did showing why there is lava and where it's coming from.you can also add smoke to the the top of the volcano so your eruption looks more realistic.
