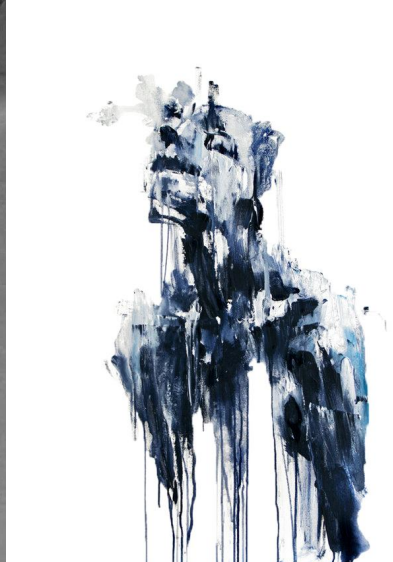
Put meaning into your work
